### SCHOLARSHIP:

Farmers State Bank is proud to award a \$1,000 scholarship to a Phillips County resident who attended high school at Logan, Northern Valley, Phillipsburg or Thunder Ridge. ### CRITERIA:

- The candidate must have a 3.00 or above cumulative high school or college grade point average.

- The candidate must display positive character traits.

### APPLICATION PROCEDURES:

- Complete and submit the attached application.
- Enclose resume application. Please include work experience, dates of employment, achievements and awards received in high school or college.
- Enclose a brief letter of application describing your educational goals, future plans and reason why you are the most deserving candidate for this scholarship. This application letter should not exceed one page.
- A copy of your high school and/or college transcript.

An official college transcript reporting first semester grades must be sent to Farmers State Bank, PO Box 544, Phillipsburg, KS 67661 in order to receive the second semester payment. Farmers State Bank reserves the right to demand repayment of the unused portion of this scholarship in case the student does not fulfill the scholarship, providing they drop out of school for reasons other than illness or something beyond their control. The decision of repayment will be made by Farmers State Bank.
